



Sustainable water management from a Spanish mining project

In a nutshell

The *Local Action Group (LAG) Valle de Alcudia* has initiated a participatory approach to address the environmental challenges posed by an upcoming tungsten mine in Abenójar. Through extensive community engagement, the project focuses on improving water quality, treating and reusing wastewater from mining operations for extensive farming and cinegetic species, for instance, and ensuring sustainable freshwater supply.

OBJECTIVES

- Ensure a sustainable freshwater supply.
- Enhance water reuse from mining operations for animal welfare and agriculture.
- Collaborate with local stakeholders and academic institutions.

ACTIONS

- Produce a scientific and technical report with work plan, methodology, benefits...
- Determine current water condition and desired optimal state.
- Carry out financial resource assessment.
